

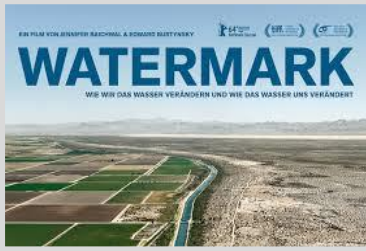

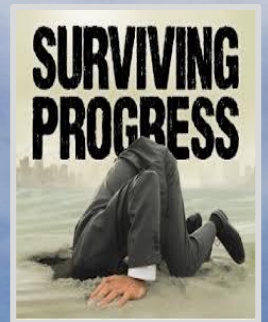
### MARCH 25, 2015

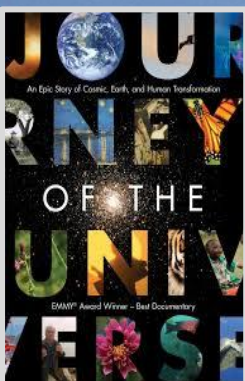
