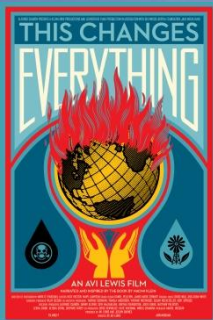


MARCH 22, 2016
