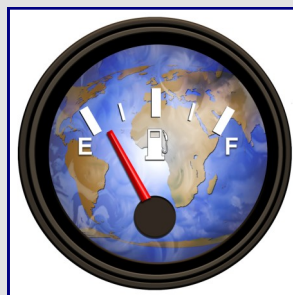
Thursday, August 19, at 7:00 pm
