- The Give to Live Furniture Project is a Rotary Burlington North initiative, which involves the collection of good quality second-hand furniture from various sources, and the donation of this furniture to families in extreme need.
- The furniture we collect is stored in two storage units generously provided to us free-of-charge by Access Storage.
- Our goal is to serve two families per month, and typically the pickup and delivery of the furniture is the responsibility of the donor or the recipient.
- Families in need can be referred to us through a variety of charitable or not-for-profit social service agencies.
