What makes your products different?

Many metallic bearings are lubricated with oil and grease. For example, every year approximately 60 million litres of operational oil from shipping leaks into our oceans and waterways. About 95% of ships still operate with an oil lubricated propeller shaft system. Thordon's products are produced using proprietary polymer materials that are lubricated with water, or self-lubricated, therefore eliminating oil or grease usage, meaning ZERO risk of oil pollution to our rivers, lakes, and oceans and are proven, cost effective, environmentally sustainable solutions.

Is there anything else you do on-site?

Similar to our commitment to create environmentally friendly products, we maintain that focus in our day-to-day practice in our office and our plant.

Thordon strives to recycle wherever possible, we reclaim our metal scraps from machining, use energy efficient light bulbs, and even accommodate employees with electric vehicles so they are able to charge them on-site.
