### How can the community show their support and take action?

## What does the Halton community need to know about this issue?

- 5,000+ acres of prime agricultural farmland in Halton is at risk for development. Once it's gone, it's gone.
- Sprawl costs us all! Low density development is expensive, where as higher density actually saves money,
- Halton region and all four of its municipalities have declared a climate emergency, so designating 5,000+ acres of farmland to development is not what we should be doing.

#### Who makes up the Stop Sprawl Halton team?

Stop Sprawl Halton is a coalition of Halton citizens from all walks of life who started organizing in February 2021 to stand up for preserving farmland, watersheds, air quality, and vibrant neighbourhoods within existing boundaries.
