PNUC is pleased to share that we have done the following:

- Installed photovoltaic (PV) system on the roof (producing local power)
- Installed electric vehicle chargers
- Replaced lights with energy efficient LEDS
- Added energy efficient appliances
- Installed skylight for passive lighting, and making use of large windows for more natural lighting
- Hosted awareness building events for youth about climate crisis, renewable energy and the PV system
- Created a Community Peace Garden, an accessible native plant & pollinator garden that welcomes community members to walk through, meditate in and enjoy the space - set to launch in 2022
- Beginning the process of "Green Certification," which will look at various energy audits, building energy efficiencies, etc.
