  - <u>Preservation of Greenspace</u>: Develop a comprehensive greenspace inventory; Outline a clear preservation plan including prioritization of preservation areas and a plan to acquire land as necessary; Declare Burlington a Food & Water first community with no development on prime farmland and watershed areas; Protect natural habitats and encourage biodiversity
  - <u>Urban Canopy protection and enhancement</u>: Develop and implement an effective private property tree protection bylaw; Encourage planting and increase urban canopy
